## Farm Tractor and Hot Farm Tractor Classes 2020 Rules and Regulations

**Thursday, August 6, 2020 – 7:00 p.m.**

**Entry Fee: \$20.00 per tractor**

**Weigh In: 3:00 – 6:00 p.m. Scale closes at 6:00 p.m. SHARP – NO EXCEPTIONS**

**Winnebago County Fair, 500 East County Road Y, Oshkosh, WI**

**Enter pits off of State Highway 76**

**Tractors can pull in only one class – no jumping classes.**

**The same driver may enter multiple tractors.**

**Classes and schedule are subject to change.**

### **Farm Classes**

Class	Weight	Pace
A	6,500 lbs.	4 mph
B	8,500 lbs.	Turbo and/or Non Turbo – 4 mph
C	10,500 lbs.	Turbo and/or Non Turbo – 5 mph
D	12,500 lbs.	Turbo and/or Non Turbo – 5 mph
E	14,000 lbs.	8 mph
F	17,000 lbs.	8 mph
G	22,000 lbs.	4 Wheel Drive – No Pace
H	28,000 lbs.	4 Wheel Drive – No Pace – Duals Allowed

### **Additional Farm Class Rules**

1. No Cut Tires
2. 20 inch maximum drawbar height in Classes D, E and F
3. 21 inch maximum drawbar height in Classes G and H
4. Tractor must be equipped with a 2½" clevis or pulling eye.

# **GENERAL RULES FOR ALL PULLERS**

1. **Safety first! Always think safety and act safely. Drive slowly, look around and think of others.**
2. **NO ALCOHOL WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE PIT AREA!!!!**
3. **No alcohol may be consumed by drivers before or during pulling a tractor.**
4. Two wristband passes per paid tractor entry fee. Wristbands are for grounds admission only. Carnival rides are extra.
5. All contestants enter at their own risk.
6. Order of pull within each class will be determined by lottery drawing at registration. All tractors must post pull number on side of tractor.
7. Drivers must be age 14 or over. Age 14 – 18 must have written permission from parents or guardians to enter tractor pull and present a farm safety course certification. Drivers must be 18 or over to drive in open or un-paced classes.
8. Driver must remain in seat at all times and operate the tractor in a safe manner at all times on and off the track.
9. All tires must be on the tractor, no tracks allowed, no cut tires.
10. All tractors will be weighed and drawbar checked as you line up for your class, any tractor can be re-weighed after pull be promoter's request.
11. The pull will start with a tight hook-up; **NO JERKING!**
12. If anything falls off the tractor before it is unhooked from the eliminator, the tractor is disqualified.
13. The officials have the right to stop any entry at any time during the pull. Pay attention to the officials, their word is final.
14. Any tractor violating track boundary will be measured from that point if they stop promptly, otherwise, it will be disqualified.
15. Drawbar height not to exceed 20" except for four-wheel drive classes. Drawbar must be at least 18" back of center of rear axle. Drawbar must be rigid in all directions. (No Floating Drawbars!)
16. All drivers are to be in line and ready to pull at the start of their weight class.
17. No registrations after the scale closes at 6:00 p.m.

## **Additional Rules for Farm Classes**

1. RPM's will be stock in farm classes. They will be checked with a hand tach, if in question.
2. Tires: 18.4 x 38 up to 8,500. No cuts of any kind.
3. Weights may not extend more than 24" in front of the tractor casting. In the back, the weight can be any reasonable distance. All weights must be securely fastened and not interfere with the hook up of the tractor to the sled.
4. Stock core injection pump in all farm classes.
5. No nitrous, alcohol or ether allowed, stock fuel only.
6. Farm class tractors must have a working PTO and hydraulics – No larger than 2.3 Turbos.
7. No water injection in farm classes.

## **Special Farm Rules**

1. RPM's will be 3,000 in special classes. Special class tractors will be plugged into eliminator to monitor RPM's. Tractors must have visible wires from the sending unit to the plug, and plug must be accessible to back of tractor. The plug on the back of the tractor must be female.
2. Weights: Weights may not extend more than 24" in front of the tractor casting. In the back, the weight can be any reasonable distance. All weights must be securely fastened and not interfere with the hook up of the tractor to the sled.
3. Drawbar heights: 20" in all classes (rigid in all directions).
4. No nitrous, alcohol or ether allowed, stock fuel only!!
5. Special and Open Classes must have safety equipment; air shut offs, wheelie bars, and cross bolts in exhaust pipe.

## **13,500 lb. N.E.W. Class Rules**

1. Pace: 7 – 10 miles per hour. No Grace. First puller has option to repull.
2. 2,800 RPM's.
3. Top cut tires, 20.8 x 42 maximum
4. No water injection
5. Stock core pumps
6. One turbo

Speed limit will be drawn at the tractor pull. (7, 8, 9 or 10 miles per hour)

Once the number is drawn, that number will not be used again for three more pulls in this class.
