SMALL PETS

Judging: Thursday at 12:00 Noon

RULES:

1. **NEW!** Each exhibitor must provide a 4x6 or 5x7 photo of their animal mounted to white or black tag board (exhibitor may also be in the photo). Entry tag must be attached to the mounted photo and visible when viewing photo from the front. Ribbons will be attached to your entry tag/photo for display throughout the rest of the Fair. Exhibitor will turn photos in to the Superintendent/Clerk at time of judging. Photos are required to receive Premiums.
2. All small pet exhibitors must be present for judging or may designate another member to show the animal. Designation must be done with the Department Superintendent prior to judging day.
3. Judging will be based on the Danish System.
