

DEPARTMENT 18 – CULTURAL ARTS

Judging: Monday 1:00 – 7:00 PM

RULES:

1. Maximum of **20 entries** per exhibitor in Cultural Arts Department.
2. Paintings, drawings, and wall hanging objects must be ready to hang. All pictures must have appropriate hanging devices attached for the size and weight of the project. The use of a hanger that will accommodate an “S” hook for display is encouraged. Consider binder clips for single layer mounted projects. Yarn, string, pop tops, paper clips, coat hangers, etc. are not acceptable hanging devices.
3. No migratory feathers, nests or eggs allowed for exhibition.
4. For poster regulations, see Rules & Regulations – Jr. Division.

Division A – Leathercraft

RULES:

1. Original design, modeling, stamping, dyeing and painting is permitted.

Division D – Drawing and Painting

RULES:

1. All items **MUST** be mounted, matted or framed, except classes 117, 121-127. 8" x 10" minimum size (including frame or mount).
2. See Rule 3 above for hanging requirements.
3. All entries must be signed and dated and visible to the judge.
4. All chalk and pencil drawings should be sprayed to prevent smudging.
5. No copyrighted images.

RULES:

1. Vocal and instrumental performances, bring a copy of sheet music for the judge.
2. Performance limited to three minutes.
3. Bring own equipment for pre-recorded exhibits and for dance performances or accompaniment.
4. Must supply your own instrument and musicstand.
