

2021 GENERAL RULES FOR ALL TRACTOR PULLERS AT
THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS

1. **SAFETY FIRST! Always think safety, always act safely. Drive slowly, look around and think of others.**
2. **NO ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED IN THE PIT AREA!!!!**
3. Tractors can pull in only one class.
4. Two wristbands come with paid tractor entry fee. Wristbands are for grounds admission only, carnival rides are extra.
5. All contestants enter at their own risk.
6. Order of pull within each class will be determined by lottery drawing at registration. All tractors must post pull number on side of tractor.
7. Drivers must be age 14 and over. Age 14-18 must have written permission from parents or guardians to enter tractor pull and present a farm safety course certification. Drivers must be 18 or over to drive in open or non-paced classes.
8. Driver must remain in the seat at all times, and operate the tractor in a safe manner at all times on and off the track.
9. Kill switches, wheelie bars, and fenders are highly recommended but, are not mandatory except in the un-paced classes. Wheelie bars must be strong enough to hold the tractor when tested. If no wheelie bars, the tractor will be flagged to stop when the front wheels exceed knee high above the ground.
10. All tires must be on the tractor, no tracks allowed, and **no cut tires except for Hot Farm.**
11. All tractors will be weighed and drawbar checked as you line up for your class, any tractor can be re-weighed after the pull by the promoter's request.
12. The pull will start with a tight hook-up; **NO JERKING!**
13. If anything fall off the tractor before it is unhooked from the eliminator, the tractor is disqualified.
14. The officials have the right to stop any entry at any time during the pull. Pay attention to the officials, their word is final.
15. Any tractor violating track boundary will be measured from that point if they stop promptly, otherwise it will be disqualified.
16. Drawbar must be at least 18" back of center of the rear axle. Drawbar must be rigid in all directions (**NO FLOATING DRAWBARS!**)
17. Tractors must be equipped with a 2 ½ " clevis or pulling eye. Height will be checked on scale.
18. No alcohol may be consumed by drivers before or during the pulling of a tractor.
19. All drivers are to be lined up and ready to pull at the start of their weight class.
20. No registrations after the start of each respective class.
21. Official decision made at the driver's meeting take priority over printed rules.
22. **HAVE SOME FUN; THAT IS WHAT WE ARE ALL HERE FOR!! Thank you for coming out to the fair!**

2021 ADDITIONAL RULES FOR FARM CLASSES

1. Tractors in Class "A" must be 1960 or newer if from outside Winnebago County, Wisconsin.
2. RPM's will be stock in farm classes, 3000 in special classes. They will be checked with a hand tach, if in question.
3. Tires: 18.4x38 up to 8,500 lbs. **NO cuts of any kind.**
4. Weights: weights may not extend more than 24" in front of the tractor casting and in the back, the weight can be any reasonable distance. All weights must be securely fastened and not interfere with the hook up of the tractor to sled.
5. Drawbar height is dependent on the class. (Drawbar needs to be rigid in all directions and clarification on the height can be found on the Winnebago County Fair Rules page. Classes do have different heights.
6. Stock core injection pump in all classes.
7. Pace: classes are paced according to weight, for pace specifications, refer to weight sheet.
8. No nitrous, alcohol, or ether allowed. Stock fuel only.
9. Farm class tractors must have a working PTO and hydraulics. No larger than 2.3 turbo.
10. No water injection in farm class.

SPECIAL FARM RULES

1. RPM will be 3000 in Special Classes. Special class tractors will be plugged into the Eliminator to monitor RPM's. Tractors must have visible wires from the sending unit to the plug. Plug must be accessible to back of tractor. The plug on the back of the tractor must be female.
2. Tires: 18.4x38 up to 7,500 lbs, any size after 7,500 lbs.
3. Weights: Weights may not exceed 24" in front of tractor casting. In the back, the weight can be any reasonable distance. All weights must be securely fastened and not interfere with the hook up to the sled.
4. Drawbar height: 20" in all classes (Rigid in all directions.)
5. No nitrous, alcohol, or ether allowed. Stock fuel only.
6. Turbo: 2.4" intake max in 7,500 lbs special class. The engine must be less than 320 cubic inches.
7. Special and Open Classes must have safety equipment; air shut-offs, wheelie bars, cross bolts in exhaust pipes.
