



# Fair Ticket Tips for Exhibitors

## Who Needs to Buy Fair Passes/Tickets? You do!

Anyone wishing to enter the fairgrounds **Wednesday August 3 – Sunday, August 7** between the hours of **9:00am and 10:00pm** must have a pass/ticket/wristband. This includes exhibitors, parents, grandparents, youth organizational leaders, etc. for judging, supporting youth, food court workers, barn duty, expo monitors, etc.

## What passes/tickets are available?

<b>Youth Exhibitor Bands</b> \$6 for a week-long wristband	<b>Fair Membership Passes</b> <b>\$30/week in Advance</b> (\$35 after July 15 & @ Gate)	<b>Daily Tickets</b> <b>\$12/day in Advance</b> \$15/day at the Gate (Aug 3-7)
Includes unlimited entry into the fairgrounds ALL WEEK, and ALL entertainment, grandstand shows, concerts, etc.	Includes unlimited entry into the fairgrounds ALL WEEK, and ALL entertainment, grand stand shows, concerts, etc.	Includes unlimited entry into the fairgrounds for <b>ONE DAY</b> , and ALL entertainment, grand stand shows, concerts, etc. on that DAY.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Great for youth exhibitors: 4-H, FFA, SCOUT members who are coming to the fair 1 or more days between Aug 3-7, but are not going on the rides.</li> <li>A must have for animal exhibitors (to take care of animals daily).</li> <li>These bands are meant to help keep fair costs down for Exhibitor Families. Wrist bands may be purchased for SIBLINGS of exhibitors, but are not available for the general public.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Great for parents, siblings, leaders, etc. who are coming to the fair every day, but are not going on the rides.</li> <li><b>Needed for families that are planning to camp at the fairgrounds for the week.</b> Camping Questions? Call Steve Stark @ 920-420-5003.</li> <li>Makes pass “owner” a voting member of the Fair Association – so you can vote at the Annual Meeting in December to help direct the future of the Fair (or run for a position on the Fair Board).</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Purchase these if you want to go on RIDES (even if you are purchasing another pass for daily entry).</li> <li>Purchase these for someone coming to the fair 1 day. (Or 3 of these for someone coming 3 days – more than that? We recommend buying a membership)</li> <li>Daily tickets are not date-specific. They can only be used ONCE, but can be used for ANY day of the Fair. BUY NOW, decide your date to attend the Fair later.</li> <li>Great gift for grandparents, family members or friends who want to come out to the fair to support youth!</li> </ul>
These are usually purchased through your Club/Chapter leader in June/July.
